- Raise awareness and build community support for the U=U campaign.
- Identify barriers to acceptability of U=U message and develop and implement advocacy strategies to mitigate these barriers.
- Help monitor/track country level U=U campaign progress and activities, including sharing best practices with other Ambassadors.
- Participate in scheduled U=U Africa Forum capacity building training and webinars.
